Summer heat of Nayagaon with poor sanitation and unhealthy environment, number of red zone children has started rising in certain areas where there is open drainage with sewage block. The rise of figures generates serious concern. The open drainage and unhygienic condition are prevalent in Hawra lines in Adarsh Nagar and Safeda Colony. These are one room sets which the owners have constructed for their livelihood. Most of these owners themselves reside in Chandigarh. This has to be brought to the notice of Health Department of Punjab Government.

<u>Common ailments among Children</u>= Indigestion, Fever, Diarrhea, Loss of appetite, speech problems, intestinal problems.

<u>Common ailments among Females</u>= Menopause, Leucorrhea and Arthritis, joint pain, acne, backache.



NUTRITION TRAINING

In nutrition demonstration, Health Promoters are given demonstration on low cost high protein and high calorie recipes. Once a month a test is conducted to examine the cooking skill of HP's.



- Date of nutritional demo-16th April 2019
- Name of health promoters on duty- SHP Maya, FC Sanjeev, HP Poonam
- Name of the dish- Sail Roti (Nepalese dish) with sesame and mint chutney, Gulgule (Indian sweet dish) with chocolate sauce
- Ingredients- jaggery, flour, peanuts, chocolate, sugar, oil, sesame seeds, mint leaves, fennel seeds.
- Nutritional value- one serving of Gulgule gives 212 calories and 3gm protein, one serving of sail roti (one ring) gives 350 calories (Medium size) and 18gm protein.

Both the dishes are delicious and healthy. These are popular dishes amongst children who enjoy eating. These are popular dishes amongst adults as well which they relish and enjoy.



NUTRITION IMPROVEMENT PRIORITY

PROGRAMME

In April we had 32 children in our feeding program. Most of the families are away to their respective villages. This is the harvesting season and the famous festival Baisakhi is celebrated with zeal and gusto amongst the villages. Our strength of NIPP children usually drops during this period.

As mentioned earlier, most of the families in this month have gone to their respective villages. This explains the drop in total number of NIPP children in this month.

- 16 Children with same weight were NEWLY added in the NIPP program since there was no improvement on their weight gain for last few months in spite of deworming and personal counselling.
- Children who have lost weight is due to heat leading to loss of appetite and diarrhea. Some kids lost weight due to fever with cough and cold.
